STEENBRAS RIVER GORGE & CRYSTAL POOLS HIKING TRAIL

PERMIT REGULATIONS & HIKING INFORMATION

(This is not a permit)

This area is closed in winter and is only open from 1ST November to the end of April.

A carrying Capacity of 50 persons per day are allowed. All permits are issued on a pre-booking system.

TARIFFS: R60.00 per/person (as per City of Cape Town Tariff document) All fees include VAT

The following information will assist in ensuring that your visit is a safe and enjoyable experience. Your co-operation in adhering to the following is therefore requested:

- You must be fit in order to complete this trail.
- You must be in possession of a pre-booked and paid permit in order to enter this area.
- A minimum of 3 and a maximum of 10 persons are allowed per group.
- No children under the age of 12 years are allowed.
- Entry times are from Sunrise until Sunset
- Watch the weather for flash floods, the river can rise meters in minutes. The gorge is situated below the Steenbras dam slues gates, which may also be opened at any time.
- First time hikers for the kloofing routes must be guided by an experienced kloofer. Jumping off cliffs is dangerous and is not recommended.
- The hiking permit does not authorize abseiling activities.
- Hikers must wear suitable hiking shoes and take the necessary equipment with them ie: food, water, first aid kit, warm item of clothing, cellphone for emergencies.
- Reserve office hours are from 8 am to 4 pm on weekdays only. In case of emergencies call: 021 957 4725 ext:2413061.
