

KEEP KWADUKUZA POWERED-UP!

MUNICIPAL GEYSER PROJECT

Official municipal notice to residents

KwaDukuza Municipality together with Eskom Integrated Demand Management (IDM) have embarked on an initiative to install an additional 3500 geyser ripple relays to reduce the electricity load by controlling hot water usage during peak times. This technology will help KwaDukuza Municipality to better manage its electricity load and help improve the network performance during network constraints.

The following residential areas have been identified to install the additional geyser relays for this phase:

Ballito

Sheffield

Foxhill

Shaka's Rock

Shakaskraal

Salt Rock

Zimbali

Tinley Manor

All gated estates within the mentioned areas

Part of this initiative involves conducting audits of existing 'geyser load' and potential new relay installation in households in the mentioned areas.

A team of trained staff from Nationwide Electrical will be approaching residents to gain access to their households, to conduct this crucial geyser relay installation exercise.

In order for this project to succeed, Eskom and KwaDukuza Municipality would like to make an appeal to residents to please give the installation team your full co-operation by allowing them into your residence and making the necessary arrangements to have the unit installed in your premises.

Please note that the contractors will identify themselves with security cards and you may feel free to take their names and vehicle registration number to verify these details by dialling **086 122 8222**.

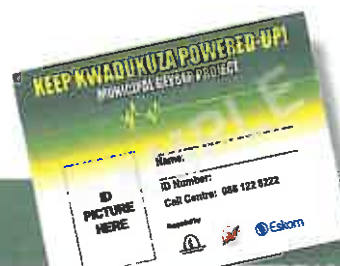
The Municipality is looking forward to the residents' continued support in assisting KwaDukuza Municipality and Eskom to achieve the Demand Side Management targets.
