GRANT CRITERIA

- The total amount a grant for a project can be applied for ranges from R5 000 to a maximum of R50 000.00. Limited funds are available, so a mix of small, medium and large grants will be funded.
- Preference will be given to applications that have local, lasting and broad impact
- Applications for seed funding are acceptable but, in such cases, future plans must be made clear and sustainability must be addressed
- If you are not a registered NPO, PBO or NPC, you should preferably link with a suitable reputable, registered NPC who will undertake to hold and be accountable for your funds. If no suitable partner is available, NVT can play this role.
- The project must aim to benefit a group or people or an area or address an issue under the following these:
 1. Reduce waste to landfill through community based recycling or awareness initiatives.
 2. Improve home-based community food generation through community based food security initiatives, establishing groups that grow and market high quality organic vegetables.
 3. Development of community eco-venture enterprises, specifically around hiking, trail-running and mountain biking, especially in coastal areas.
 4. Alleviating high levels of dog breeding and associated animal welfare (and ecological issues) through dog sterilisation and education programs in local communities.
 5. Improved management of local coastal and marine biodiversity through revision, education and enforcement of key municipal by-laws that are causing issues with the public.
- The application must stipulate exactly what the funding will be used for and the time in which it will be used (i.e. project activities with times frames and associated costs must be provided).
- Applications must be submitted electronically, as original Word documents using this form.
- Closing date for initial applications is 22nd November 2019. Successful applicants will be contacted by the 30th December 2019. Contracts will be finalized by 21st January 2020 and projects should aim to start by 1 February 2020.
