

Shiraz / Syrah

Boschkloof

Stellenbosch | Complex and attractive bouquet of oriental spices with pronounced violet and white pepper. Lovely perfumed red fruit aromatics. Very classic style with unmistakable Rhone flavours.

Hartenberg Estate Doorkeeper

Stellenbosch | Fine white pepper, dark forest berries and whiffs of caramel on the nose. The palate displays blackberries and cranberries with a savoury touch.

Zevenwacht Estate

Stellenbosch | Concentrated blackberry and plum that opens to a floral perfume with white pepper and herbs on the nose. The palate has dense fruit intensity, a velvety mid palate and finish with a fine peppery tannin.

Pepper Street Solid Syrah by Rudi Schultz

Stellenbosch | Beautiful aromas of dark berry, cherry and pepper with seamlessly integrated tannins and seductive hints of mocha, earth and spice adding to the complexity, which in turn follows through on the lengthy palate.

Stark-Condé Stellenbosch

Stellenbosch | Concentrated dark-fruit aromas with liquorice, violet and white pepper notes. The palate is rich and broad with layers of fruit and a dine-grained tannin structure.

Neil Ellis Groenekloof

Groenekloof, Darling | The nose has hints of raspberries with contributing perfumed aromas of violets. The palate is juicy with red and dark cherries, and peppery notes lingering in the background.

Hartenberg Estate

Stellenbosch | Ripe, dark plums and chocolate on the nose with damp forest floor whiffs and clove spices. The palate is plush and the plum note carries through, along with hints of cinnamon.

Louisvale Estate

Stellenbosch, Devon Valley | The palate is silky and smooth with rich ripe plum and mulberry flavours supported by subtle oak nuances and soft ripe tannins.

Red Blends & Other Red Cultivars

Boschkloof Cabernet Sauvignon / Merlot

Stellenbosch | A full-bodied, oak matured wine. Ripe plum, red fruits and complex perfumed oak bouquet. A concentrated middle palate with long after-taste of blackberries and undertones of spice.

Doolhof Single Vineyard Malbec

Limietberg | *"Home of Malbec - South-Africa's first single vineyard". | Vibrant aromas of violets, cocoa and black pepper. The palate shows richness and roundness with flavours of blackberries and plum.

Ataraxia Serenity

Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge | This wine has the confidence to "whisper" style rather than "shout" brashness through the winemaking excesses of fruit ripeness, extraction in the cellar or an overtly strident use of new oak barrels.

Boschkloof Kottabos Grenache / Syrah

Stellenbosch | A subtle but compelling nose of red and black fruit, fynbos, white pepper and a little earth. There is nice fleshiness on entry balanced by fresh acidity and grippy tannins.

Ataraxia Marroquin Cinsault

Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge | This expression of Cinsault causes one to pause and muse. It draws one in and urges one to pay a little bit more attention. The wine seeks to explore the seductive, sleek side of Cinsault's persona.

Hartenberg Mackenzie - Bordeaux Blend

Stellenbosch | Vibrant red fruit aromatics on the nose with touches of tobacco and cassis. A note of forest floor lifts from the glass. The palate is elegant, plush and velvety all at once with flavours of plums and cherries underpinned by an earthy tone.

Neil Ellis - Webb Ellis

Groenekloof & Jonkershoek Valley | The aromatics proclaim red and dark fruits. Notes of liquorice, black olives and cedar are noticeable. The palate is seamless, sophisticated, rounded and stylish. Combining the structure of Cabernet Sauvignon with the richness of Syrah, Webb Ellis exemplifies the judicious balance of fruit and oak.

Cap Classique and Sparkling

Weltevrede The Ring - Blanc de Blancs

Robertson | Lemon grass, fynbos-honey, cucumber, melon and mint leaves makes for a complex nose. The palate is crisp and focussed with flavours of green apple, citrus and mint leaves.

M·A·N Family Wines - Sparkling

Agter-Paarl | 100% Chenin Blanc. Crisp and light-bodied, with a beam of fruit and balanced acidity. Fresh apples, white peach, citrus and a hint of minerality on the palate.

Groote Post Brut Rosé

Darling Hills | Salmon-pink tinged with flavours of strawberry and hints of yeasty biscuit. It is crafted according to the age-old tradition of second fermentation.

Franschhoek | Fresh citrus and lime on the nose with delicate white floral nuances. The palate is fresh and linear with white peach and green melon and finishes with soft mineral undertones and bright acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc

Doolhof Mountain Range

Limietberg | Dominated by lovely tropical notes with underlying green figs and goosberries on the nose. It is underlined with a core of mineral flavours.

Strandveld Pofadderbos - Single Vineyard

Cape Agulhas | Passion fruit, grape fruit and blackcurrant on the nose. Creamy and full on the palate with citrus, fynbos and oyster shell minerality complemented by a lovely natural acidity and a long finish.

Groote Post Seasalter - Blanc Fume

Darling Hills | Wonderfully expressive on the nose and the palate with captivating notes of black current, stone fruit and green apple together with hints of fynbos and kelp, sea-breeze and a touch of oak.

- Old Vine

Stellenbosch, Bottelary Hills | * Top 10 Standard Bank Chenin Blanc Challenge | Rich, deep, complex nose of bruised yellow fruits, white peach, creamy and plush, showing honeyed pineapples and leesy yellow fruits. Plenty of gravitas, fruit weight, focus and textural complexity.

Ataraxia

Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge | In the most accurate and faithful way possible, our wooded white wine mirrors the terroir in which our Chardonnay vines are grown. In other words, it is an expression of the low vigour, stony, clay-rich Bokkeveld Shale derived soils and the heavily maritime-influenced climate.

Hartenberg Estate

Stellenbosch | On the bouquet the wine shows alluring aromas of white pear, elderflower and subtle hints of toasted vanilla and white flowers. The palate is fresh yet creamy with ripe pear and citrus acidity following through. Well-integrated oak with a toasty and lingering finish.

Eikendal Vineyards

Stellenbosch | A charming light onion skin hue with delightful rose petal, fresh strawberries and raspberry flavours on the nose, that follows through to the palate.

Darling | Dry Provence-style Rosé. A bright bush of juicy cherry fruit fills out the palate. Floral and spicy notes linger, along with the slightest tang of sea salt.

Agter-Paarl. Aromas of dark cherries and chocolate, followed by cassis and red fruit flavours on the palate. Ends with silky tannins and a long smooth finish.

Stellenbosch, Devon Valley. This wine boasts a generous nose of graphite, blackcurrants and dusty herbs. Elegant dark fruits and an intense perfumed nose.

Stellenbosch, Jonkershoek Valley. Intriguing and appetizing nose with blue and blackberries and typical cedar aromas from the Jonkershoek Valley. The palate is nervous and fresh, followed by a well-defined tannin structure.

Agter-Paarl | Pleasing aromas of mocha and roasted coffee beans, followed by juicy flavours of red berries, nutmeg and vanilla spice on the palate.

Kaapzicht Estate Rooiland

Stellenbosch, Devon Valley | Modern, yet classic style of Pinotage. Generous notes of blackberry, mulberry and blackcurrant are present on the nose, while rich oak and vanilla spice creates a lasting and textural finish.

Lievland Bushvine

Stellenbosch | Vibrant aromas of cherry, raspberries and a hint of cedar and vanilla from the oak maturation. The palate shows ample red fruit and a delicious savoury note.
