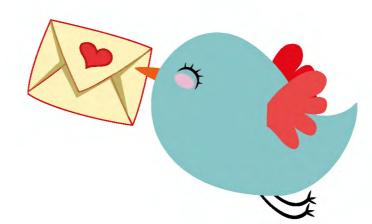

Bananas are berries, but strawberries A pomegranate can hold up to 1400 seeds. ... Cranberries can bounce. ... A pumpkin is a fruit. ... Potatoes were the first vegetable to be grown in space. ... Not all oranges are orange. ... Figs match milk in calcium. ... Kiwis contain more vitamin C than oranges.

Which fruit is good for skin?

We need vitamin C to support the immune system, promote radiant skin and help blemishes heal. The best sources are blackcurrants, blueberries, broccoli, guava, kiwi fruits, oranges, papaya, strawberries and sweet potatoes.

A diet rich in vegetables and fruits can lower blood pressure, reduce the risk of heart disease and stroke, prevent some types of cancer, lower risk of eye and digestive problems, and have a positive effect upon blood sugar, which can help keep apposite in check keep appetite in check.

Which fruit has no seed?

Common varieties of seedless fruits include watermelons, tomatoes, grapes (such as Termarina rossa). Additionally, there are numerous seedless citrus fruits, such as oranges, lemons and limes. A recent development over the last twenty years has been that of seedlesş śweet peppers (Capsicum annuum).

Facts about Donkeys



The domestic donkey is a hoofed mammal in the family Equidae, the same family as the horse. It derives from the African wild ass, Equus africanus, and may be classified either as a subspecies thereof, Equus africanus asinus, or as a separate species, Equus asinus.

What are 5 interesting facts about donkeys?
Animal Aid Abroad
A donkey is stronger than a horse of the same size.
Donkeys can see all four of their feet at the same time.
Donkeys can vary hugely in size, from 26 inches to 68 inches tall.
A donkey's bray can carry up to 60 miles in the desert.

What are donkeys scared of?

Donkeys also have a natural dislike of foxes, coyotes, wild dogs, and other members of the canid family. They can be taught to tolerate them, but their instincts will never really go away.

What is donkey behavior?

Donkeys are not like horses; they differ physically, mentally and emotionally. Donkeys are more stoical in their behaviour and tend to startle less than horses. Compared to horses, donkeys show limited fear response to novel situations and this can be mistaken for stubbornness rather than fear.

Which is smarter donkey or horse?

Donkeys are quite intelligent, even more intelligent than horses. You are likely to find that your donkey may need to "decide" to obey your commands, rather than obeying them routinely

Do donkeys like humans?

Bullying in schools...

hat are the effects of bullying on school children essay?

Some of the effects comprise anxiety, post-traumatic stress disorder, lack of self-esteem, gastric issues, relationship issues, and addiction to alcohol and drug. Most of the victims need years of treatment and therapy to get over their psychological trauma caused by the bully.

What type of movement is anti-bullying?

The anti-bullying movement was based on the premise or theory that students are unable to stop bullying on their own. It views kids as victims, completely powerless to change their situation without outside intervention.

How effective is bullying prevention?

This meta-analysis found that anti-bullying programs were collectively effective in reducing school-bullying perpetration by around 19-20% (odds ratio = 1.309) and school-bullying victimization by around 15-16% (odds ratio = 1.244)

At what age does the greatest amount of bullying occur among students?

While bullying occurs in every age group, bullying happens most often in middle school. Thirty-one percent of bullying occurs in sixth grade, more than any other grade level. Bullying looks different at different ages. Physical bullying is more common in elementary school.

Are schools effective in stopping bullying?
Specifically, it was found that school-based anti-bullying programs were effective overall in reducing school-bullying perpetration by approximately 19%-20% and school-bullying victimization by approximately 15%-16%.

What is a good slogan for stop bullying?

Don't be a zero, be a hero and refrain from being a bully. Don't let anyone EVER dull your sparkle. Don't stand by stand up, stand strong together. Don't stand by, stand up against bullying.

STOP Bullying

here's so much for our children to learn in today's high-tech world that it can become easy for them to miss out on practical life skills. In fact, a 2014 study by the security company AVG Technologies found that while 57% of 3- to 5-year-olds can navigate at least one app on a smartphone, only 14% could tie their shoes.

"I see many parents doing everything for their kids instead of letting them fend for themselves," says Tim Elmore, founder of <u>Growing Leaders</u>, a nonprofit in Atlanta that works with schools and civic groups to promote leadership qualities in kids. "We must prepare the child for the path, not the path for the child."

By focusing on life skills early on, you can do just that. Read on for tips on teaching your young kids practical skills.

Preparing a Simple Meal

Invite your child to help make meals and do your best to stay calm when the flour spills and the eggshells fly. Some ideas to get young children started in the kitchen:

- Practice cutting a banana with a plastic or wooden knife.
- Let pre schoolers spoon yogurt into a bowl and add cut prewashed fruit.
- Show kids 5 and older how to make sandwiches and smoothies.
- Let those 7 and older try using the toaster oven.

If you gradually add to their developing kitchen skills, your child should be able to use the stovetop with supervision by age 10.

Using the Web Wisely

With kids spending more time on screens than ever before, it's essential to reinforce a few rules to help them safely navigate the digital world.

If they are to young put a parental code on with certain times that they can use there device.

- Help your child choose a password that's hard to guess and tell them to never share it with anyone except you.
- Ensure your child only chats with people they know in real life and doesn't give out personal information such as their birthday, home address, or phone number.
- Remind your child to be kind; anything they send or say virtually is there forever.
- Have your child get permission or ask for help from you before downloading something or clicking a pop-up.
- Most importantly, let your kid know they can come to you with any issue. "This is a conversation you will have again and again as your children get older.

Doing the Laundry

Too many teens head out on their own without knowing how to clean their clothes. Don't let your child become one of them.

You can begin laundry lessons when kids are around 6. If you have a top-loading washer, keep a step stool nearby. Walk them through the process—how to measure and add the detergent, choose the settings, and start the machine—and make it fun.

- 1. Prepare a spot to plant a seedling. If possible, add about 2 inches of organic compost to the top of the soil. Mix it in, break up dirt clods, and water the soil until it's almost as moist as a wrung-out sponge.
- **2. Dig a hole.** Ask your child to dig a hole slightly larger than the plant's container.
- **3.** Remove the seedling. By age 6 or 7, kids can remove a seedling on their own. First, have your child split two fingers apart so the plant's

so the plant's stem goes between them. Then turn the potted seedling upside down and squeeze the outside of the container until the plant comes out. If the roots are wound tightly, your kid should loosen them a few at a time before planting.

4. Plant it! Once you remove the plant from the pot and place it in the hole, have your kid delicately push soil around it and pat it down.

5. Water. Let your child water it with a gentle stream from a watering can with a perforated nozzle.

Writing a Letter

Letter writing is a lost art, but it doesn't have to be. Toddlers can dictate a note to a family member or a friend (enhanced with drawings, of course), attach the stamp, and drop it into a mailbox. Older children can pen their own letters and address envelopes. You can also take the opportunity to teach them the five parts of a letter: date, greeting, body, closing, and signature.

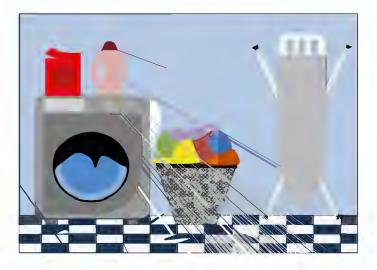
Treating a Wound

To help your child doesn't freak out when they see blood, do your best to avoid having a big reaction yourself. Giving them a <u>first aid game plan</u> will also help distract them from the pain and come in handy when you're not around to kiss their boo-boos.

To treat a minor cut.

- 1. Washing your hands with soap and water to avoid contaminating the wound.
- 2. Washing the cut with soap and lukewarm water to remove dirt and debris.
- 1. Pressing firmly on the area with a clean cloth until it stops bleeding (usually one or two minutes)
- 2. Applying petroleum jelly with a cotton swab to keep the wound moist.
- 3. Covering the wound with an adhesive bandage or gauze and tape
