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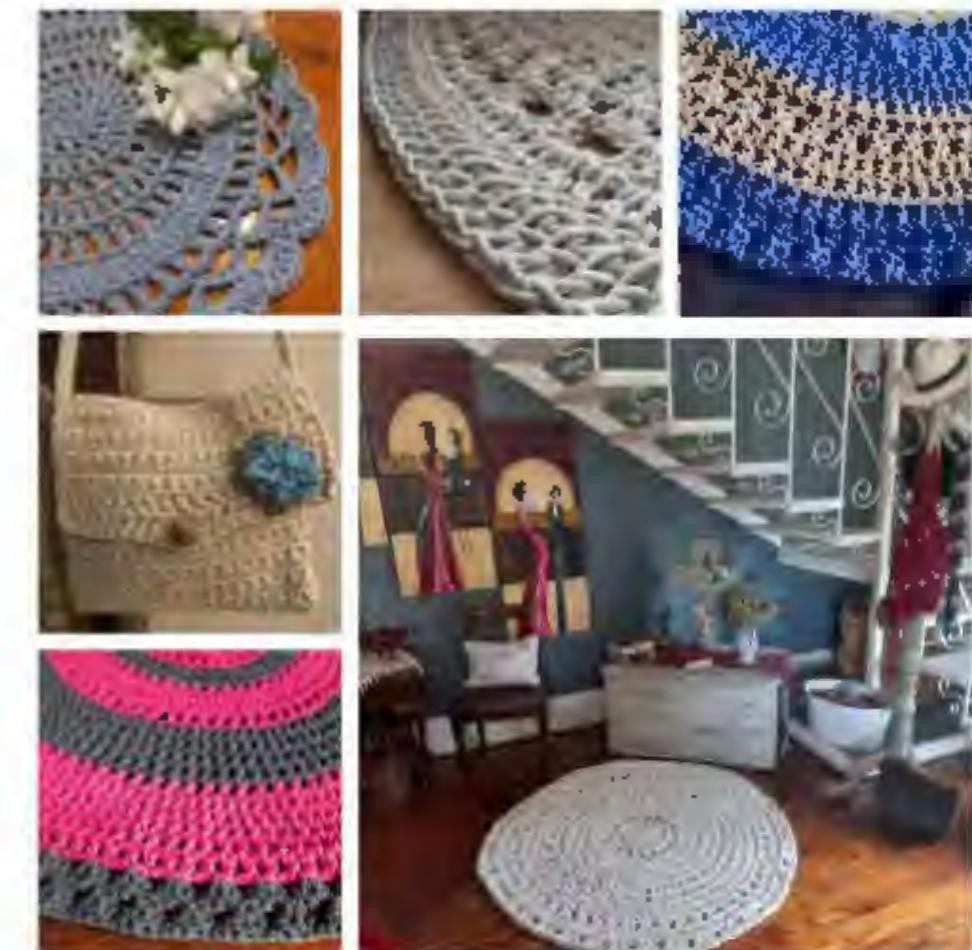

Growing up in a digital world

Digital technologies have profoundly changed childhood and adolescence. The internet and the means to access it, such as tablets and smartphones, along with social media platforms and messaging apps, have become integral to the lives of youth around the world.

They have transformed their education and learning, the way they make and maintain friendships, how they spend their leisure time, and their engagement with wider society.

UNICEF's *State of the World's Children 2017: Children in a Digital*

World report reveals that one in three internet users is younger than 18 years and 71% of 15–24-year-olds are online, making them the most connected age group worldwide. However, the so-called digital divide is substantial: 346 million youth are not online, with African adolescents the most affected (60% are not connected compared with 4% in Europe).



Young people who lack digital skills, live in remote regions, or speak a minority language are also being left behind in harnessing the opportunities that digital technologies can provide. These benefits include access to education, training, and jobs, which can help break intergenerational cycles of poverty, and access to news and information sources that can help protect their health, safety, and rights.

Along with the substantial opportunities the digital age brings, come a diverse range of risks and harms. Digital technologies have increased the scale of child sexual abuse and exploitation. Child sex offenders have increased access to children through unprotected social media profiles and

online gaming forums. Technological advances have allowed individual offenders and trafficking rings to evade detection through encrypted platforms and the creation of false identities, and have enabled them to pursue multiple victims at the same time.

Young people are not only at risk from adult exploitation; children can also obtain sexual or intimate photos of a peer and share them with or without the individual's consent. Digital advances have meant that bullying is no longer left at the school gates; [cyberbullying](#) is a new method for bullies to hurt and humiliate their victims with the click of a button. Words and images posted online that are designed to cause harm are also difficult to delete, increasing the risk of re-victimization.

[Concerns](#) have also been raised about the time children spend using digital technology and its effect on their physical activity and mental health. Evidence suggests moderate use of digital technology can be beneficial to children's mental wellbeing, whereas excessive use can be detrimental. Children's social relationships seem to be enhanced by digital technology,

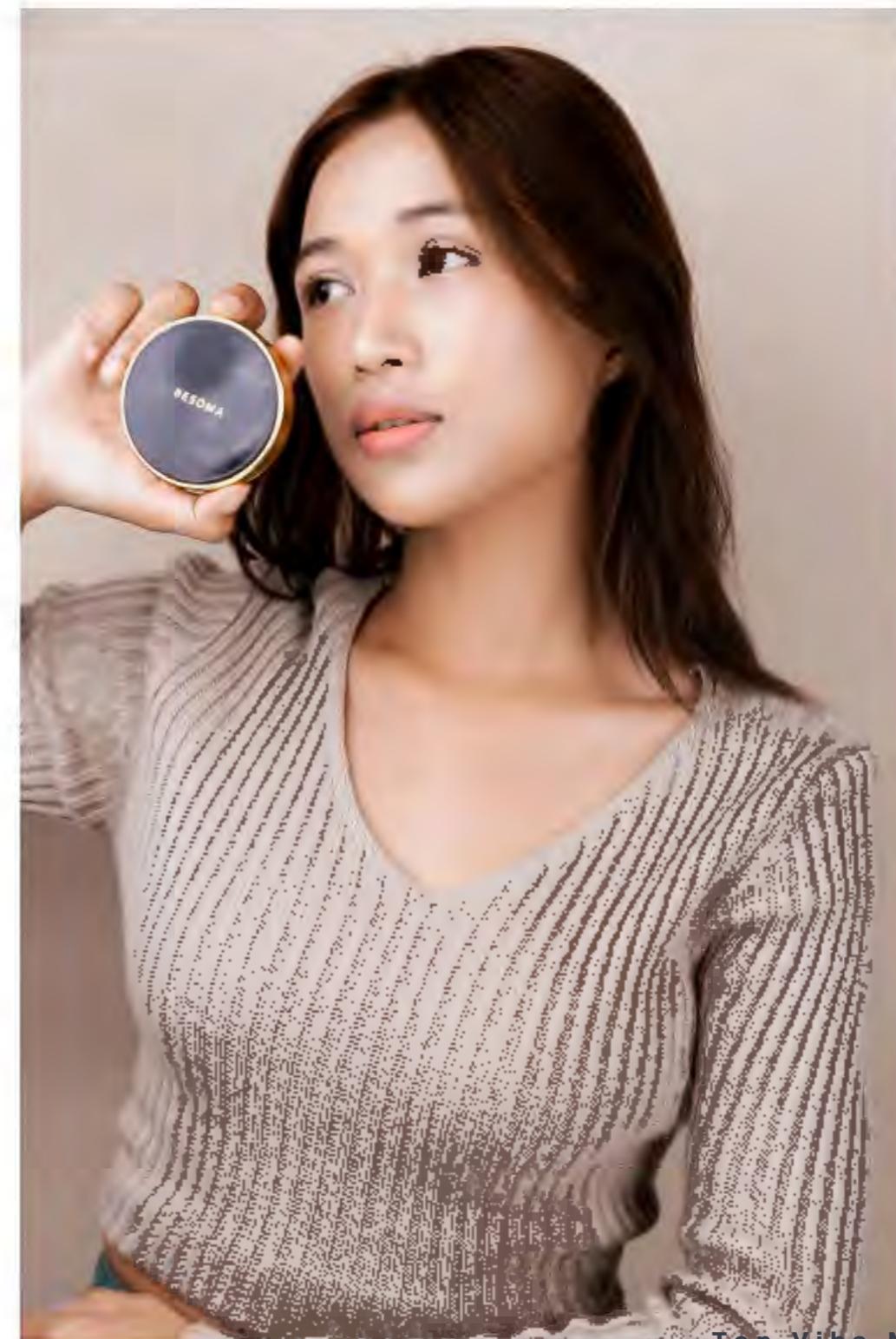

STEPHAN VISAGIE WIL BOSVELD TOE IN NUWE ENKELSNIT SAAM HENRI ALANT!

Stephan Visagie, 'n gerekende sanger en liedjieskryer in die Afrikaanse musiekbedryf, het in samewerking met die talentvolle musikant, Henri Alant, 'n nuwe enkelsnit vrygestel genaamd "Vergeet My Hier". Die liedjie is beskikbaar op alle digitale platforms vanaf 21 April 2023.

Stephan Visagie is 'n trotse lid van die legendariese Vonk Musiek, wat bekend is vir die ontdekking van baie bekende en suksesvolle kunstenaars in die Afrikaanse musiekbedryf. Hy is reeds bekend vir sy treffer "4 Keeps", wat hom in 2017 in die kollig geplaas het. Sedertdien het sy musiekloopbaan 'n stroomversnelling ondergaan en sy werk word tans hoog aangeskryf in die musiekbedryf.

"Vergeet My Hier" is die perfekte opvolg enkelsnit na Stephan se vorige uitgawes, insluitend "Amper Daar", wat in 2022 bekendgestel is. Hierdie nuwe liedjie het egter 'n heeltemal unieke tema wat uit Stephan se liefde vir die bosveld gebore is - 'n plek wat hy beskryf as sy "Happy Place".
