Facts about Ants

Ants hold the record for the fastest movement in the animal kingdom.

Ants can be found on every single continent except Antarctica.

Ants are social insects which live in colonies.

Ants don't have ears, and some of them don't have eyes!

The largest ant's nest ever found was over. 3,700 miles wide!.

What is interesting about ants?

The ant is one of the world's strongest creatures in relation to its size. A single ant can carry 50 times its own bodyweight, and they'll even work together to move bigger objects as a group! Ants carry leaves and twigs back to their nests!

How many stomachs do ants have?

Ants have two stomachs

They have two stomachs, and it isn't because they're greedy. One stomach is for holding food sources for their own intake, while the second stomach is to hold food sources to be shared with others. The process is referred to as trophallaxis and permits a colony to work efficiently.

What color do ants hate?

The study involved pair choice trials, in which workers were digging and removing colored glass beads. The beads were blue, green, yellow, orange and red. Based on the count of removed beads, S. invicta workers do have color vision and have a preference for green, orange and red and least prefer blue.

How long do ants sleep?

A recent study of ants' sleep cycle found that the average worker ant takes approximately 250 naps each day, with each one lasting just over a minute. That adds up to 4 hours and 48 minutes of sleep per day. The research also found that 80 percent of the ant workforce was awake and active at any one time

Tea Gift Box

Tea is the name of the game in this sophisticated gift basket.

Even the basket itself is lined with a tea towel! Include a bag of pancake mix, a jar of fresh jam, ripe apples, and loose-leaf tea for a gift that's as delicious as it is nice to look at.

Book Spine Bookmark

Have an old book that can't be saved? If the spine is salvageable, use it to help dad mark his place in the next novel he reads.

To make:

Using a utility knife, remove the spine, then line the inside with patterned contact paper. Punch a hole at the top and thread twine through.



DIY Koozie

Dad will be filled with joy while sipping cans of his favorite summer chiller out of this DIY drink koozie.

To make:

Cut a length of craft foam that is just shorter than a can. Wrap around can and cut the length so that it just overlaps itself. Have kids draw a picture on the foam with fabric markers. Add a piece of velcro to the back to keep it closed.



Business Card Holder

Stitch up vintage postcards to make a slim wallet or business card holder.

Here's how: Fold the postcard in half with the decorative side face up, and cut a half-moon from the top front of the postcard.

Open the card flat and cover with a sheet of clear. lightweight vinyl; stitch all around the postcard, 1/4-inch from its edge. Trim vinyl to fit and refold the postcard in half.

Sew the wallet around three edges, leaving the top open.



Winter Safety Tips for Children...

___ayer up!.

Dress your child in several layers, and make sure their head, neck and hands are covered. Dress babies and young children in one more layer than an adult would wear.

Beware of clothing hazards. Scarves and hood strings can strangle smaller children so use other clothing to keep them warm.

Check in on warmth. Before kids head outside, tell them to come inside if they get wet or if they're cold.

Then keep watching them and checking in. They may want to continue playing outside even if they are wet or Use sunscreen. Children and adults can still get sunburned in the winter.

Use caution around fires. Wood-burning stoves, fireplaces and outdoor fire-pits are cozy but can present danger – especially to small children. Use caution and put up protective gates when possible. If you've lost power or heat and are alternative heating methods like kerosene or electric heaters, be sure smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors are working. cold.

Get trained and equipped. Children should wear helmets when riding a bicycle. And to avoid injuries, teach children how to do the activity safely.

Prevent nosebleeds.

If your child suffers from minor winter nosebleeds, use a cold-air humidifier in their room. Saline nose drops can help keep their nose moist.

Keep them hydrated. In drier winter air kids lose more water through their breath. Offer plenty of water, and try giving them warm drinks and soup for extra appeal.

Don't forget the accessories: Kids' heads, hands and feet get cold quickly, so be sure they have a warm hat and mittens or gloves to wear. Thick socks, along with some winter boots or rain boots, are also important.

So ensure that you feed your child plenty of hearty meals consisting of some good winter foods that help keep their energy up and keep the sniffles away.
