





My ouers self het altyd gesê: 'Kom laat julle gaan speel, die groot mense wil praat!' – Was dit altyd 'n goeie ding? Moet ouers nie dalk sekere gesprekke met mekaar hê met die wete die kinders luister nie?

Wel, ek dink so! Hier is so 4 gesprekke wat ek voel ouers moet hê terwyl hulle weet die kinders hoor hulle.

1. Laat hulle hoor hoe jy omverskoning vra:

"Piet ek is regtig jammer oor vanoggend, ek was ongesik en kort af en dit was nie regverdig teenoor jou nie. Ek is lief vir jou"

Dit leer kinders om te herken wanneer hulle verkeerd was en om omverskoning te vra op 'n vroë ouerdom.

2. Laat hulle hoor hoe jy probleme op los:

"Ek het so gesukkel by die werk vandag! Ek kon nêrens my dagboek kry nie. Ek was so bekommern en het orals gesoek. Ek het aanhou soek en soek. Toe vra ek om hulp en bel my Ma om te hoor of ek dit nie daar gelos het gisteraand nie en wraggies ek het toe! Ek was so verlig toe ek weet waar my dagboek was."

Wanneer ouers gaan toelaat dat kinders sekere gesprekke hoor, soos probleem oplossing, hoe om met ander te praat en hoe om jou emosies te hanteer dan leer jy dit vir hulle ook sonder dat jy weet.




Tehane Grobler an 8 year little girl is currently a model at C & C Modeling school in the Vaal. She love to take part in charity Runs where she loves to help.

She currently won in her category and won the Face of Top Vibe Kids title.



There are about 32,000 species of living fish in the world.

There are more fish in the world than mammals, amphibians, birds and reptiles combined!

Sharks are the largest fish.

What are 5 characteristics of fish?

General Characteristics of fish & features of fishes

Characteristic of fish
Ectothermic.
Lateral line.
Two chambered heart.
Gills used for respiration.
No external ears.
No eye lids.

What can fish do?

5 amazing facts that'll change the way you think about fish ...

Fish are excellent learners.

Fish can learn how to use tools, build nests and, in some cases, outperform primates with their learning abilities. Some fish have figured out impressive ways of obtaining food, like squirting jets of water from their mouth to capture insects above the surface and using rocks to open shells.

What are the 4 features of a fish?

All fish have backbones (vertebrae) for support and movement. Suggest that students memorize the initials "WGFB" to assist them in remembering the four main traits of fish: "Water, Gills, Fins, Backbone."

Do fish sleep?

While fish do not sleep in the same way that land mammals sleep, most fish do rest. Research shows that fish may reduce their activity and metabolism while remaining alert to danger. Some fish float in place, some wedge themselves into a secure spot in the mud or coral, and some even locate a suitable nest.

What do fish eat?

Fish generally eat other fish but their diet can also consist of eggs, algae, plants, crustaceans, worms, mollusks, insects, insect larvae, amphibians, and plankton.

Do fish get thirsty?

Fish have gills that allow them to "breathe" oxygen dissolved in the water. Water enters the mouth, passes over the gills, and exits the body through a special opening. This keeps an adequate amount of water in their bodies and they don't feel thirsty.

Can fish see water?

If we can't see air can fish see water?

No, fish can't see water just like you can't see air. It's their natural environment, so they don't have the ability to perceive it visually. However, fish can sense water through other means, like detecting vibrations and changes in pressure.

U.S. Presidents

Abraham Lincoln stood at 6 feet 4 inches making him one of the tallest U.S. presidents. Bill Clinton has two Grammy Awards. Three of the nation's five founding fathers — John Adams, Thomas Jefferson and James Monroe — died on July 4th (Adams and Jefferson in 1826 and Monroe in 1831). The shortest-serving president was William Henry Harrison, who was the ninth president of the United States for 31 days in 1841. Franklin D. Roosevelt is the only American president to have served more than two terms.

Disney.

Tiger roars were used for The Lion King as lions weren't loud enough. Walt Disney World resort is about the same size as San Francisco. Mickey Mouse was the first animated character to receive a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. Pocahontas is the only Disney princess with a tattoo. Disney's Beauty and the Beast was the first animated film in history to be nominated for Best Picture at the Academy Awards.

Food

Ears of corn generally have an even number of rows. Although Froot Loops cereal signature "O's" come in many colors, they're all the same flavor. Applesauce was the first food eaten in space. The Caesar salad was born in Tijuana, Mexico. One out of every four hazelnuts on the planet makes its way into a jar of Nutella.

Guinness World Records

The "Guinness Book of World Records" was first published in 1955. The Simpsons is the longest-running animated television show (based on episodes).

The world's largest wedding cake weighed 15,032 pounds.
