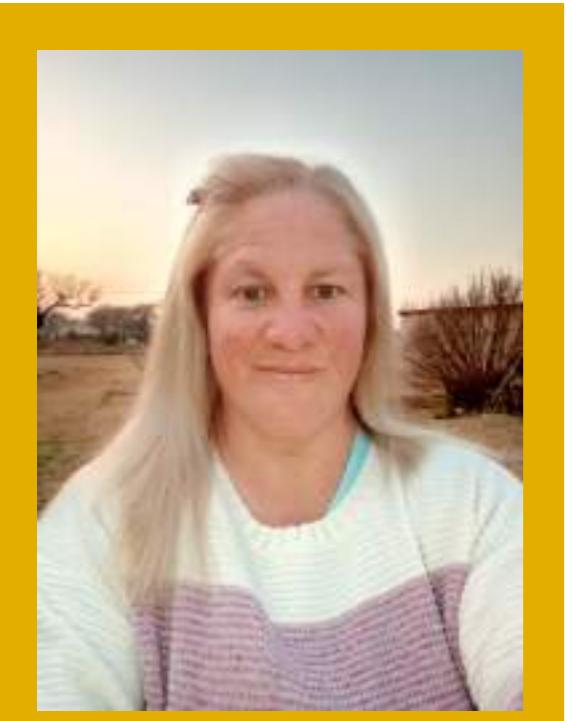

In 2013 het ek ook by die Universiteit van Pretoria my uitgebreide funksies diploma gedoen. Ek het ook reeds 14jaar se Ortodontie ervaring..Die eerste twee vrae wat baie mense my vra is..Hoe het jy besluit op die beroep? Hoe kan jy heeldag in iemand se mond werk? Op vraag een het ek steeds nie n presiese antwoord nie. In Gr 9 het ons beroepsvoortiging gehad en moes vak keuses maak,die onderwyseres het n paar voorbeeld genoem en een was Mondhygiene. Dit het my gefasineer en ek het meer navorsing gaan doen daaroor en daar besluit dit is wat ek wil word. Ek was baie bevoorreg om keuring te kry by die universiteit toe dit by aansoek kom aangesien net 20 kandidate n jaar by tukkies gekeur word. Vandaar is dit geskiedenis wat my by die tweede vraag uitbring. Ek doen dit elke dag omdat dit vir my lekker is. Dit is lekker om n pasient se vertroue te wen en hulle te kan onderrig in mondgesondheid. Dit is so lekker om te sien n bang pasient wat in jou stoel sit en benoud loer na alles om hulle stap uit met selfvertroue en n glimlag.

Waarom moet jy n Mondhygienis gaan besoek? Dit is ons doel om ons pasiente te leer van goeie mondhygiene en mondgesondheid. Hoe om gaatjies en tandvleis ontstekking te voorkom, en van kleins af n goeie tandeborsel roetine te leer. As kinders van n jong ouderdom af die Mondhygiene besoek elke 6 maande is hul vrees baie minder vir die dag wat hul in die tandarts se stoel moet gaan sit. Ons leer hul van klein af hoe om tande te borsel en die belangrike deel, hoekom hulle dit moet doen. Ons leer hul van die goggas wat lekker partyjie hou daar in hulle mond en gewoonlik rek hul ogies en wil dadelik weet hoe kan hulle die goggas weg kry.

Volwasse pasiente se roetine besoek elke 6 maande kan groot tandheelkunde werk voorkom aangesien ek as mondhygienis jou mond

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ondersoek en kyk vir probleme, help jou as jy sensitiwiteit het en gee raad oor regte tipe tandeborsel, tandepasta, mondspoel en vlos. Ek kan jou dan verwys na n tandarts as ek iets sien wat nie reg is nie. In so geval is dit net soms n klein gaanjie omdat ons dit vroeg opgetel het. Mondgesondheid speel ook n baie groot rol in algemene gesondheid.

Die gesondheid van jou tandvleis en tande is direk gekoppel aan die gesondheid van jou hart, longe en diabetes. Dit is dus sinvol dat jy tandvleis en tande gesond kan hou op meer as een manier tot goeie gesondheid. Ek weet die tandheelkunde spreekkamer is n plek wat meeste mense baie angstig en bang maak en dis ook hoekom hul net die spreekkamer besoek wanneer daar iets pyn en dan is dit soms te laat vir daardie tand. 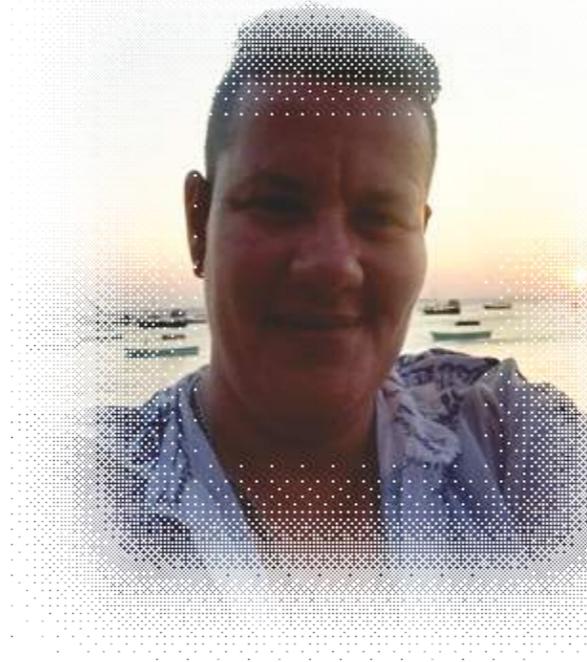

UNDERSTANDING BISEXUALITY

UNDERSTANDING BISEXUALITY

Bisexuality is a topic that is mostly avoided for any number of reasons. Although it is still considered a taboo subject in some social circles, it requires some airtime, particularly as we start navigating the changing face of sexuality and relationships in South Africa.

The gender binary identifies the value that society assigns to “real” men and women. We distinguish between the “hegemonic” male (the dominant male or ruler) and “emphasized” female (nurturer and caregiver). The sexuality binary emphasises heterosexuality as “normal”, thereby pathologizing other forms of sexual behaviour, such as

bisexuality. Heteronormativity may therefore reinforce the ideology that heterosexuality is the normal or preferred sexual orientation, which may result in heterosexism, which is a prejudice against homosexuality. The family binary recognises the heteronormative value of a family and its legal ties as genuine, compared to other “pseudo” forms of relating, such as living together.

Having said that, one of the needs participants in my research suggested, is the need to explore bisexuality. Exploring bisexuality is not necessarily possible in a heterosexual relationship (a man and a woman). My research suggest that engaging in CNM facilitates the meeting of other

parties who may be willing to engage in this type of sexual activity.

In some instances, the need to explore bisexuality originates from one or both individuals wanting to explore a sexual fantasy. This fantasy motivates the person to explore platforms where they could live out this bisexual fantasy – mostly in the context of a threesome. My research also alluded to the bisexual element of engaging with so-called “she-males” .

It was evident from the interviews that two views were represented with the theme of acceptance of male bisexuality. On the one hand, CNM is reportedly a safe space to explore sexual fluidity and bisexuality, conversely, the other view suggests a

a strong heteronormative undercurrent, where particularly heterosexual males were adamant they would not tolerate any form of homosexuality. This view is not only prevalent among heterosexual men, it seems to surface among the heterosexual women too.

Bisexual/homosexual men tend to label this attitude as machismo. Some extend the notion to the fact that some heterosexual males deny their bisexuality because they are too scared to admit they have bisexual fantasies, or justify their heteronormative stance through their religiosity. It is not uncommon for bisexual/homosexual men to renounce draconian indoctrination due to the sex negativity enforced by the doctrine.

While bisexuality is not unique to either gender, my research suggests that there is a gender bias in the fulfilment of bisexual curiosities in men. The findings of this study showed that women are more likely to express the need to explore bisexuality than males. While female bisexuality is regarded as more acceptable than male bisexuality,

it is suggested that male bisexuality is deemed as an example of men negating their hegemonic and dominant masculinity ideals. For a woman to be bisexual does not change her female essence. But there is this machismo that comes down to as blunt as "men have sex with women and if you don't have sex with women you are not a man. The latter provides one reason why men's bisexuality is not socially tolerated. Furthermore, the repercussions of the intolerance becomes tangible when the bisexual man experiences fear of rejection from their friends and society if they express a desire to pursue or explore bisexuality. Therefore male bisexuals are not as willing to express their desire to explore bisexuality for fear of rejection by their social groups and peers.
