

Postscript is a computer-printer control language for creating vector images. It is a world wide standard for printing and imaging as it implement rasterization.

It is interpreted by Raster Image Processors (called RIP's) and it allows you to create high quality, colour rich documents reliably.

## Encapsulated PostScript

An EPS file is a Postscript document with additional restrictions, intended to be usable as a graphics file format
